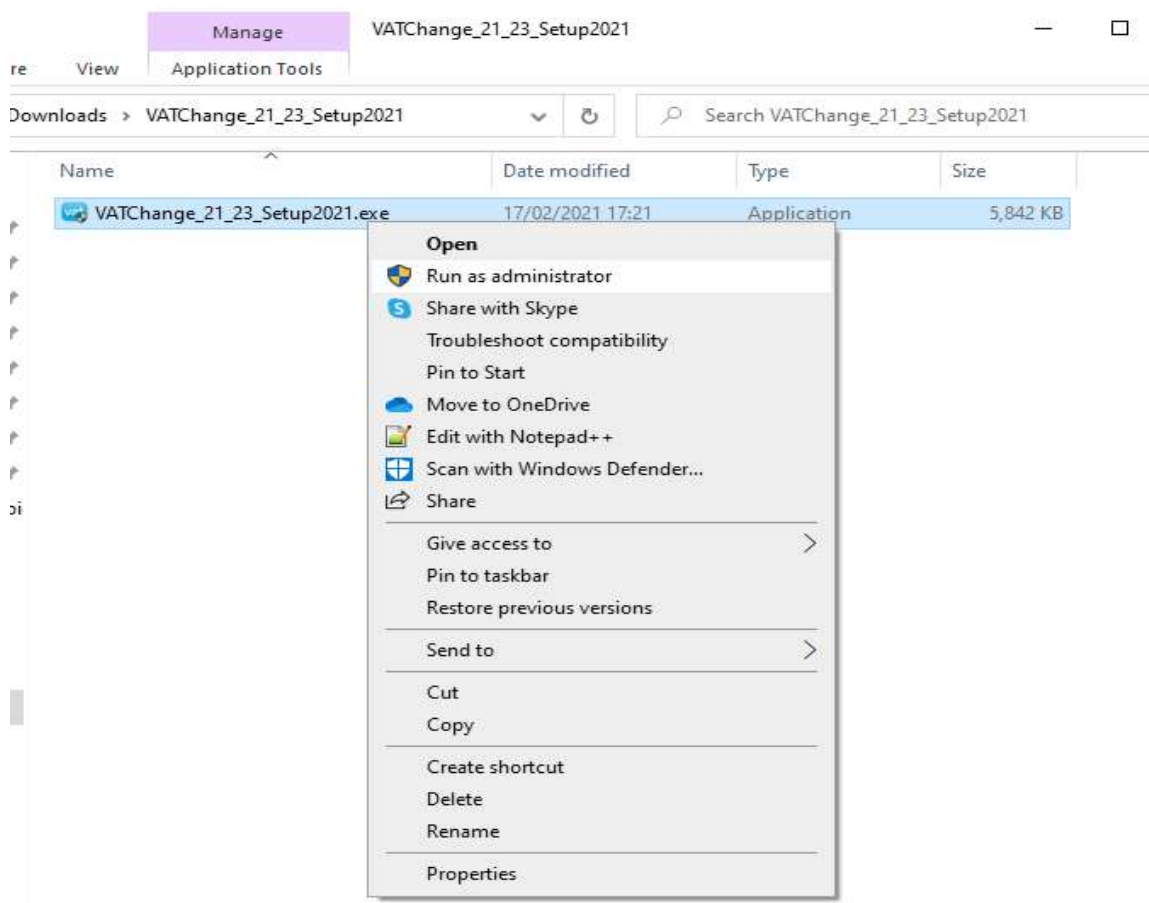
As you know the standard VAT rate is changing from 21% to 23% with effect from 1st March 2021. This will require you to change the VAT rate on the relevant departments and stockcards **after the 28th February (and after processing sales for that day and completing your cash reconciliation)**. To assist you in this we have developed a program which will allow you select your current 21% vat rate departments and 21% products to change them to the 23% VAT rate. Note that for sites with multiple back office PC's this must be run on the main StationMaster PC.

It is strongly advised that all available downloads from your wholesaler (price changes, eGRN's, electronic invoices etc) have been processed in advance of the vat changeover.

2. When you have downloaded the file locate it (default location will be the downloads folder), right click on it and select 'Run as Administrator'



3. Ensure that you allow the program through any antivirus popups
4. When running the program you will be prompted to confirm that sales processing and cash reconciliation are up to date.

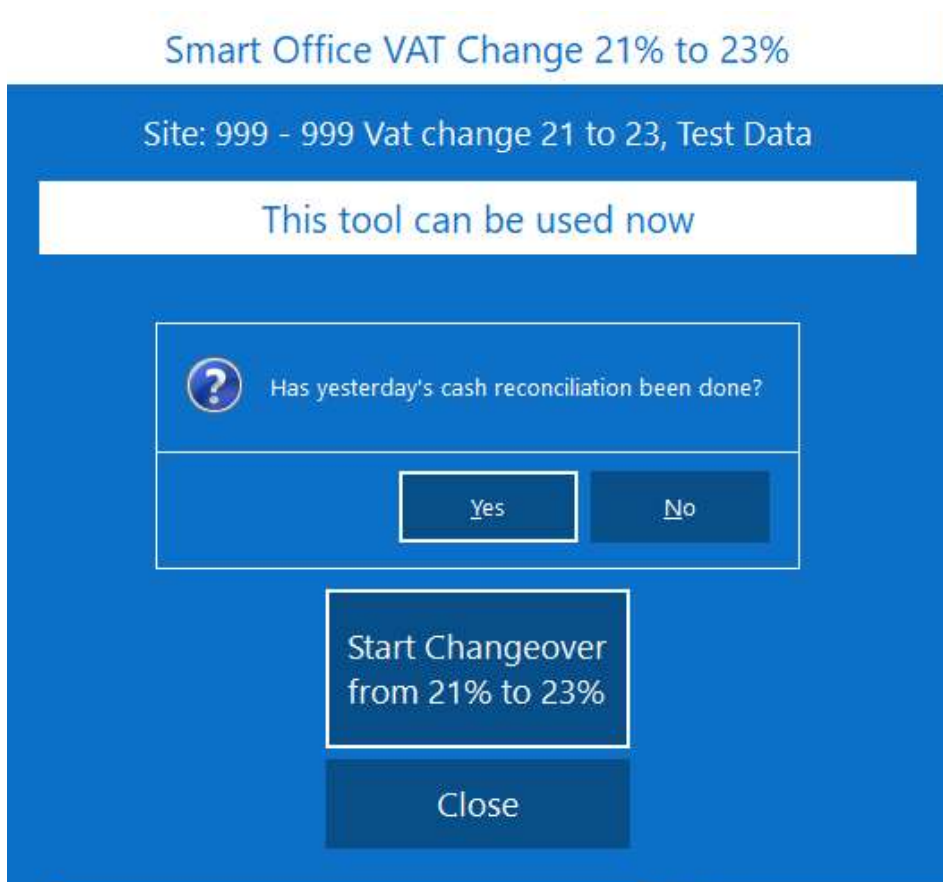

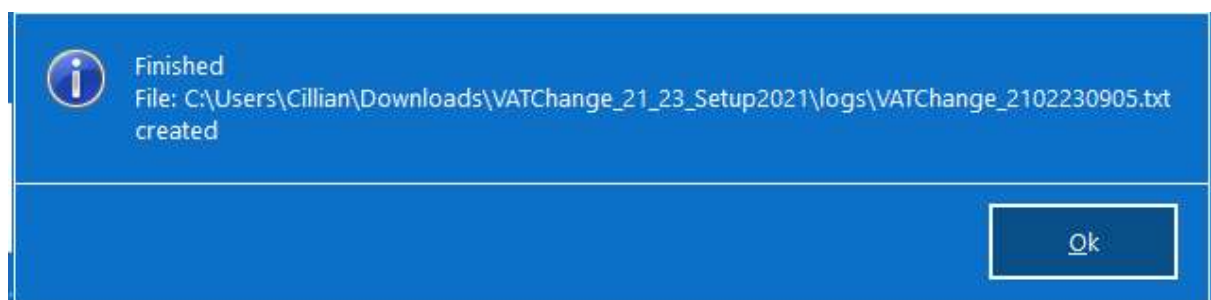

5. The program will automatically do a backup before proceeding.
6. Once the program has finished it will pop up a message indicating where you can find the text file listing all products and departments changed should you require it. This will be the same folder from which you ran the vat change program.



7. Open SmartOffice and check some products and departments to satisfy yourself that the appropriate changes have been made.
8. In SmartOffice send your full product file and departments to the till in the usual fashion.
